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Scoring

Fleet Safety Awards Scoring

- First, Second, and Third place winners are determined in each category according to the greatest mileage vs least accidents.
- First place winners are then notified and All companies with zero crash records are asked to compete for Grand Trophy
- First and Second Place winners are presented plaques from Great West Casualty Co. Third Place winners are presented certificates from Great West Casualty Co.
- Zero accident certificates are presented to all entries in each category that have no recordable crashes. Certificates are provided by Great West Casualty Co. Five Year Zero Accident Certificates are presented from MTA.
- MTA Staff will compile results and coordinate with MCSAP for confirmation of crash data.

Grand Safety Awards Scoring

The scoring panel will be comprised of mainly MDT and MVD staff involved with the trucking industry in Montana.

10 % Out of Service Safety Score

Both the Driver and Company out of service will be used equally for the Out of Service Score.

50% Application Factors

These will be rated based equally on the responses to the two questions: How the company promotes safety and how involved the company is with MTA

30% SMS Score

The Unsafe Driving, Hours of Service, Driver Fitness, Controlled Substance and Vehicle Maintenance percentages will be scored equally for the SMS Score.

10% Crashes

The number of non-preventable Montana crashes as determined by the judges will be used for this score. Zero crashes will be given the full 10%.
